Worthy Officers, Brothers, and Sir Knights,

Every day in the news we hear or read about crimes; injuries and suffering at the hands of men and women who seem to lack a moral compass. This can make us sad, or angry, often at the same time. We want those responsible to be caught and punished. Even the death penalty can seem inadequate to atone for the most heinous acts. However, as Christians, we are called to" turn the other cheek", forgive and seek the salvation of those we despise or fear.

Say to them, As I live, says the Lord God, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from their ways and live; turn back, turn back from your evil ways; for why will you die, O house of Israel?

Ezekiel 33:11

This is probably the most difficult of God's attributes to emulate. Christ Jesus died a horrible death on the Cross, but from that cross forgave those who betrayed, rejected, tortured and killed Him. "Father, forgive them for they know not what they do." Our Lord demands that we, too "take up our cross" and follow Him. Certainly, He intends for us to accept suffering but also to follow His example of forgiveness. Let us not conflate "forgiveness" and

"accountability". Anyone responsible for sin and violence remains accountable, but the mercy of God allows for the contrite of heart to be redeemed if they turn from their evil ways or actions. The good thief took responsibility and asked for mercy. The Prodigal Son took responsibility for his actions and suffered because he was accountable; but his remorse and regret freed him to apologize and seek reconciliation and acceptance as a servant in his father's house. The father's incredible mercy and forgiveness restored him fully as his son.

This is my commandment, that you **love one another** as I have **love**d you.

John 15:12

We always pray for the victims of violence and for their recovery. We want justice for them. But the love of God demands mercy as well. Forgiveness is a very powerful form of mercy. It can heal victims and perpetrators. Let us pray for those who do evil that they may be redeemed through a change of heart. A heart turned to the sinless sacrificial Lamb of God.

Over the past 7 years Rice Memorial High School has worked hard rebuilding their music program to be one of the finest in the state. Perhaps one of their strongest programs is their choir. Over 10% of the entire school is in the choir. This upcoming January 2026 they have the extraordinary opportunity to compete in an international choir competition in Kobe Japan. They will compete in the Youth Category against Choirs from all



over the world. This will challenge the Rice singers to truly reach their god given potential. In this trip they will also attend at least one Mass, perform concerts at schools with the intention of recruiting students to Rice. They will also be enriched in the culture, and history through visits to Hiroshima, Kyoto, and Tokyo. In order for the choir to be successful we need as many members to participate as possible. Chaplain's request to consider supporting Dcn Gonzalo's daughter Vanessa

Deacon Gonzalo's request for sponsorship

Hello al

Deacon Gonzalo has asked several people (and maybe the KofC?) to provide an affidavit of support for his daughter Vanessa to continue higher education in the US. I told some of you that I would share the letter I provided. A document is linked below.

This summarizes this situation in a way I think is accurate:

- Colleges won't accept an application unless they have some assurance that tuition COULD get paid even in the scenario of no scholarship or financial aid.
- Colleges won't accept proof of financing ability from Gonzalo's resources in Columbia (His savings I'm pretty sure, but also his military pension). Therefore, they want actual documentation from <u>U.S. financial</u> <u>institutions</u> (like official bank

statements). This seems to be a prerequisite to processing applications, prior to consideration of scholarship or financial aid offers.

- Providing an affidavit of financial support I do believe would be legally binding if Vanessa enrolled in a program, then studied the semester/ year, and then did not provide payment according to her family's means.
- That said, I trust Gonzalo that he and his daughter will only entertain enrollment offers based upon aid and scholarships available after application, and based upon their own financial means.
- I provided a letter of affidavit of support like this two years ago, for Vanessa to enroll in CCV classes.
 There was no indication in the past two years that Gonzalo and his family did not meet all payments for the classes Vanessa has been taking.

My tax returns would be available if more evidence was needed.




